OUR FOCUS

The suicide prevention program is working towards reducing the risk of Veteran suicide. Our program is centered on improving the Veteran's well-being and baseline mental health status while providing social support and connection to VA and community-based resources.

ELIGIBILITY

- ✓ **SERVED IN THE ACTIVE MILITARY**
Discharged or released under conditions other than dishonorable
- ✓ **SCREENING**
Mental health and well-being screening to verify some risk factors for suicide
- ✓ **FOUND TO BE AT RISK**
Be evaluated and found to be at risk of suicide using the Columbia-Suicide Severity Rating Scale (C-SSRS)

ALSO AVAILABLE TO FAMILY OF VETERAN

Over the age of 18 and only eligible to begin services after an eligible Veteran is enrolled and engaged in the program

CASE MANAGEMENT



NEEDS ASSESSMENT

Coordination of supportive services based on the administered Needs Assessment



INDIVIDUALIZED SERVICE PLAN

Development and monitoring of an Individualized Service Plan (ISP)



CONNECTION TO SERVICES

Connection to VA and non-VA suicide prevention services



REFERRALS

Referrals to community resources, activities, and peer support specialists



EDUCATION

Providing educational material on recognizing suicidal thinking and lethal means safety



EMERGENT NEEDS ASSISTANCE

Connection to services for transportation, income support, child care, and more
