Goal

The focus of the SSVF program is to promote housing stability among low-income Veteran families who reside in or are transitioning to permanent housing.

Eligibility

To become a participant under the SSVF program, the following conditions must be met:

- The Veteran must be homeless or at risk of becoming homeless.
- A member of a "Veteran family." Either a Veteran; or a member of a family in which the head of the household, or the spouse of the head of household, is a Veteran. (Note: the head of household should be identified as the Veteran.)
- Household income does not exceed 80% of area median income.

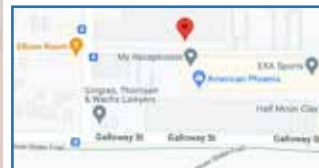
